Dear Pastor and church family,

We trust that the Lord has given you a good start to the new year. Today, January 19th, our hearts are heavy with the news of the worst high speed train tragedy in Spain's history that happened last night. Many victims and many in area hospitals recovering from different injuries.

Radel, who is from Cuba, was going to work on a Monday morning, and while waiting to cross the street at a pedestrian crossing, was struck by a car that came up on the sidewalk. He woke up in the ER with broken ribs, a punctured lung and a broken elbow and clavicle. His wife, Raquel, is a christian who had begun attending services a few months before the accident. They have 2 young girls. We prayed and God answered by helping Radel through the initial hospitalization and then through the shoulder operation. In December, Radel visited on the day of the Christmas program to thank us for our prayers. Would you pray with us for his salvation?

Christmas evangelistic outreaches. During the month of December, we plan activities with evangelism as our main focus. One of our special activities was a Christmas ladies meeting which God blessed with good attendance and a visitor. We shared testimonies and a good time of fellowship. One of our visitors, Taniwska, came to this activity for the 1st time. Haixin, the father of one of our Sunday School boys, came for the 1st time as well. He allows his 2 children to come with their mother, but had never attended personally. How encouraging to know that God answered the prayers of a young son for his dad. Pray for Haixin's salvation.

In 2026. Even as we are so grateful to God for another year to serve Him, we are also asking for His provision and guidance as we seek to win the lost and help the believers to grow in their knowledge of our Lord. The church is needing to renew the exterior signs and we are planning on having a special singles meeting among several churches in the next few months.

Help us pray for the salvation of: Emiliano, Grechel, Christopher, Rosibel, Catalina and Taniwska as well as several who need to follow the Lord in baptism. Once again this year we have handed out 300 church calendars with a QR code on each month that has a video explaining the Gospel.
